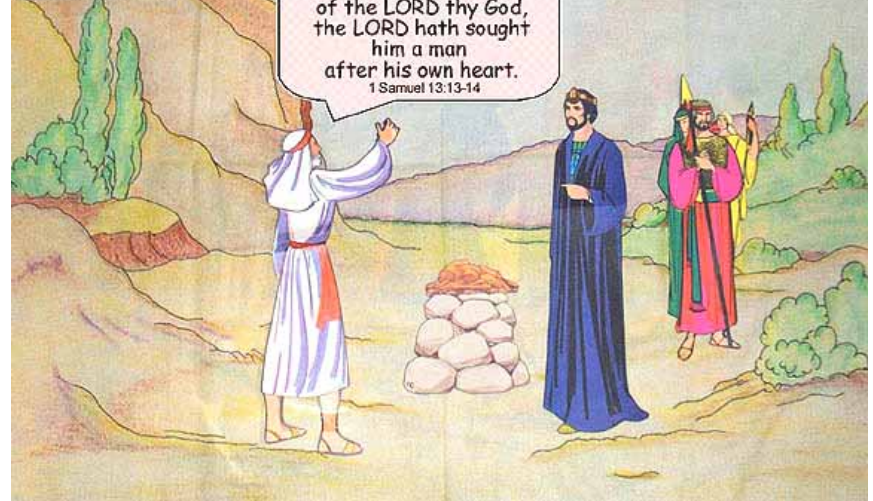
Introduction. Saul was privileged in many ways.

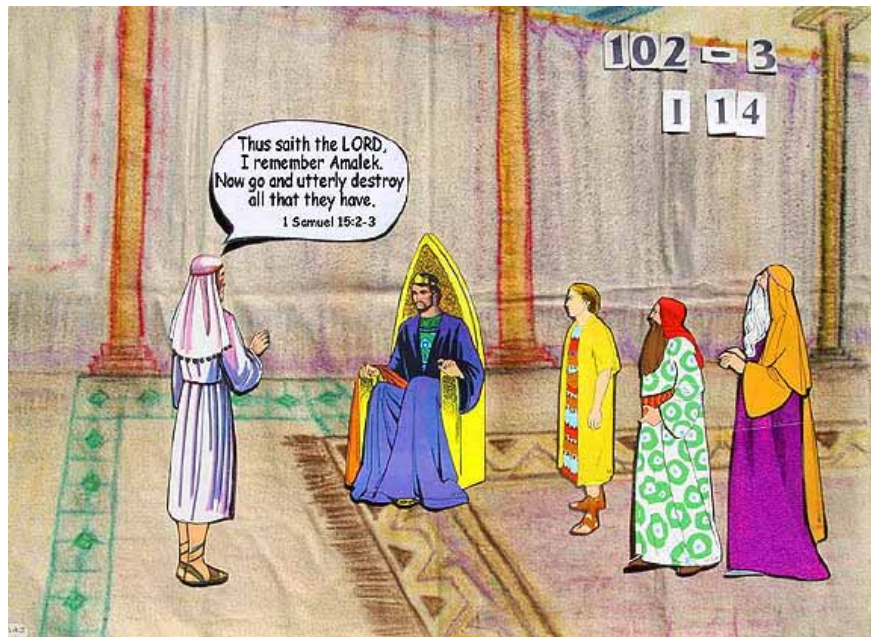

Saul is rebuked for having disobeyed the commandment of God, not waiting for Samuel to arrive. He will later be replaced by another.

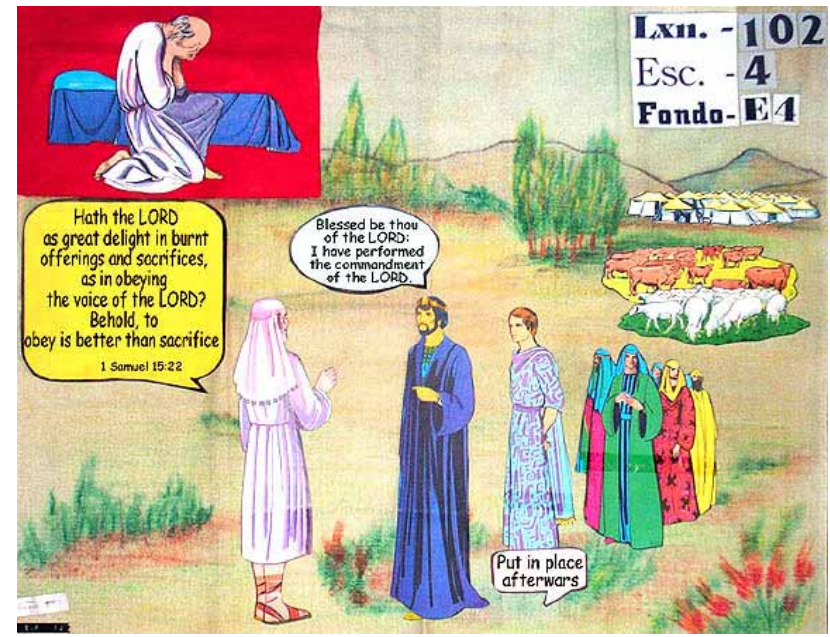


Thus saith the LORD, I remember Amalek. Now go and utterly destroy all that they have. 1 Samuel 15:2-3
